“As part of this exclusive distributorship announcement, we are delighted to launch in Australia one of Intradyn’s leading solutions – the ComplianceVault,” said Maxus managing director, Norma Tovey.

Email and other electronic communications extend beyond conversations, being *business records*, so they must be managed accordingly - be it for regulatory or legal compliance, knowledge management [email mining] or simply good business practice.

Today, many smaller sized organisations have not been able to comply with regulations for email retention mainly because of the complexity and high cost involved. “Previous archiving solutions, designed for large enterprises, are difficult for small firms to implement because they require specialised IT expertise, and go well beyond their modest IT budgets,” said Tovey.

Unlike a managed or outsourced email archiving service which charges a monthly fee per user, the ComplianceVault is a one-off purchase, requiring minimal set up and ongoing resources. It is a completely integrated hardware/software solution that can be put into use immediately capturing all of an organisation’s email on a continuous basis, from a virtually unlimited number of mailboxes

“Basically, it is an affordable, ‘drop-in’ solution to meet compliance, best practices and e-discovery needs and is available in a variety of models including desktop and rackmount,” said Tovey. “But the real attraction of this solution is that it is user-friendly with a web-based search front end allowing users to retrieve their own emails while administrators can access all emails.”

The device archives all email onto non-alterable “WORM” (write-once, read-many) tape, via an internal tape drive in the desktop models, or an external tape library. The ComplianceVault works with Microsoft Exchange, Lotus Notes, or virtually any IMAP or POP3 email system. “Setting up Microsoft Exchange for use with the ComplianceVault™ is as easy as making two mouse clicks,” said Tovey.

When attached to a network, all emails are immediately and continuously saved and indexed to disk, plus archived and indexed to tape at intervals specified by the user - making them available for

retrieval in a manner compliant with corporate policies and industry regulations. The device allows organisations to meet a variety of email retention needs, whether related to regulatory compliance, or simply for good business practice in electronic records management.

Pricing starts at only AUS\$11,750. ComplianceVault is simple to install, requiring no integration time or expense. It can be put into use immediately and has extensive search and auditing capabilities.

ComplianceVault features:

- Fast, extensive search capabilities - advanced search features, including wildcard/fuzzy/proximity/range searches - and, importantly, the ability to save searches.
- Exporting of search results - ability to easily export any email search results, directly from search results screen, to a file, CD, email, or to a printed hardcopy
- Audit features - every single access to the system is tracked, by date, time, and user
- Encryption - option of tape encryption, to safeguard stored tapes
- Captures all inbound, outbound and internal emails
- Attachments stored once only – no duplication and wasted storage space
- Works with a range of email systems (Microsoft Exchange, Lotus Notes, virtually any IMAP or POP3 system)
- Email messages automatically saved to WORM (write-once, read-many) storage
